THE MASS BOX - A SACRED AND SIGNIFICANT

MEMORIAL OR GIFT

This convenient to use Mass Box contains everything a priest needs to celebrate Mass- a full set of investments, altar linens, pyx and sacred vessels.

The Chalice and Ciborium will have the names of your loved ones (living or deceased) inscribed on them.

The neat Mass Box itself can be used as an altar if required e.g for missionary priests serving in bush

country. These Mass Boxes/Kits which may be sponsored by you from Apostolic worm for €400 are then given to priests on the missions, at their request, who pray daily during Mass for the donors and their loved ones. All of the fabric contents of the box are all made by our active members in their respective sacristies or homes

#### **COLLECTIONS**

Many thanks to all parishioners who contributed to the Easter Dues. Easter Dues can be dropped into the Parish office if you have not already done so Dues envelopes are available at the back of the Church As you are aware the Christmas & Easter Dues are sent to the Diocesan Common Fund, which provides a salary for all Priests in the diocese and supports those who are retired or ill. This year due to the fall off in Church collections all priests had a 25% decrease in their monthly salary.
